OPERATION

ARMING THE IMMOBILISER

Protection of your vehicle is automatic. Simply switch the ignition off as normal - the immobiliser will wait for approximately 30 seconds before arming automatically. As an indication that the immobiliser is armed and as a deterrent to thieves, the red light (LED) flashes.

DISARMING THE IMMOBILISER

No action on the part of the driver is necessary to disarm the immobiliser!

Attached to your key ring is a small plastic housing containing the miniature transponder programmed to deactivate your immobiliser. As you move the key towards the ignition switch to start the vehicle, the immobiliser control module interrogates the transponder and verifies that it has the correct code to disarm the immobiliser. Once this has been successfully completed, the red light will extinguish and the vehicle can be started. All this takes place almost instantaneously and it is unlikely that you would even perceive that you have an immobiliser installed.

EMERGENCY DISARM PROCEDURE

In the event of you losing the Transponders or in the unlikely event of a malfunction it may be necessary to use the emergency disarm procedure.

INTRODUCTION

Congratulations! Your vehicle is protected by an Autowatch Proximity Immobiliser system which has been designed with only the very best components to ensure maximum reliability. Using state of the art Tirus transponder technology it offers the ultimate in user convenience. Refer to the user instructions below to fully understand the operation of the system.

IMPORTANT NOTICE

1. Attached to the back of the Owner's Manual is a "Service and Override Card". This is the "Identity Document" of your immobiliser. **DO NOT LOSE IT - at the very least make sure that you record the number as it can be used to disarm the immobiliser in the event of a malfunction.** This number is also required when ordering additional Transponders.
2. Be sure that the Fitment Centre has completed the "Certificate of Installation", as this is proof of the installation, and may enable you to negotiate discounts on your vehicle insurance.

ENTERING THE EMERGENCY OVERRIDE NUMBER

Refer to the 5 digit number supplied on the "Service and Override Card". Each digit is entered individually using the ignition switch. As a comprehensive guide of how to enter the number, the following example shows how the override code number "46032" would be used.

Should you enter a digit incorrectly, wait for at least 11 flashes and simply begin entering the number again, starting from the first digit of your code.

Note that a zero is represented by 10 flashes.

1. When the light is flashing (because the immobiliser is armed), turn the ignition ON. The light will be steady on.
2. Turn the ignition OFF; and the light will start flashing. Count the number of flashes. After the 4th flash, turn the ignition on. The light will be steady on again. (This is the first digit entered.)
3. Turn the ignition OFF, and count the flashes. After the 6th flash, turn the ignition ON. The light will be steady on again. (This is the second digit entered.)
4. Turn the ignition OFF, and count the flashes. After the 10th flash, turn the ignition ON. The light will be steady on again. (This is the third digit entered.)

5. Turn the ignition OFF, and count the flashes. After the 3rd flash, turn the ignition ON. The light will be steady on again. (This is the fourth digit entered).
6. Turn the ignition OFF, and count the flashes. After the 2nd flash, turn the ignition ON. The light will flash rapidly to indicate that you have successfully entered the code and the immobiliser will disarm.

NOTE: In order to satisfy the requirements of the leading insurance companies no permanent override facility is permissible. This is a "One Event" override. You will need to enter this number every time you wish to cancel the immobiliser.

ADDITIONAL TRANSPONDERS

Additional Transponders can be programmed to disarm your immobiliser system and are available from any Autowatch approved fitment centre. The code of your immobiliser (recorded on your "Service Card") is required to program these Transponders.

CERTIFICATE OF INSTALLATION

No changes or additions should be made to the security system by any party other than an Autowatch approved Fitment Centre as this can affect the validity of the Certificate of Installation.
